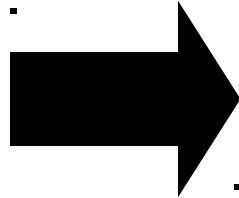

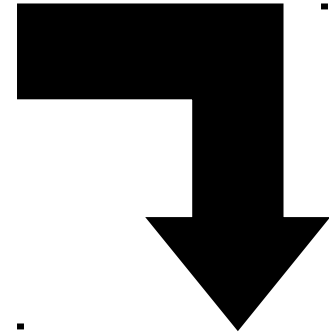




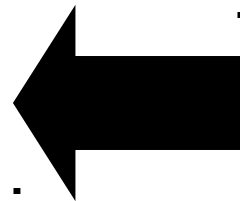
Program that a human being understands



Program written in Language X

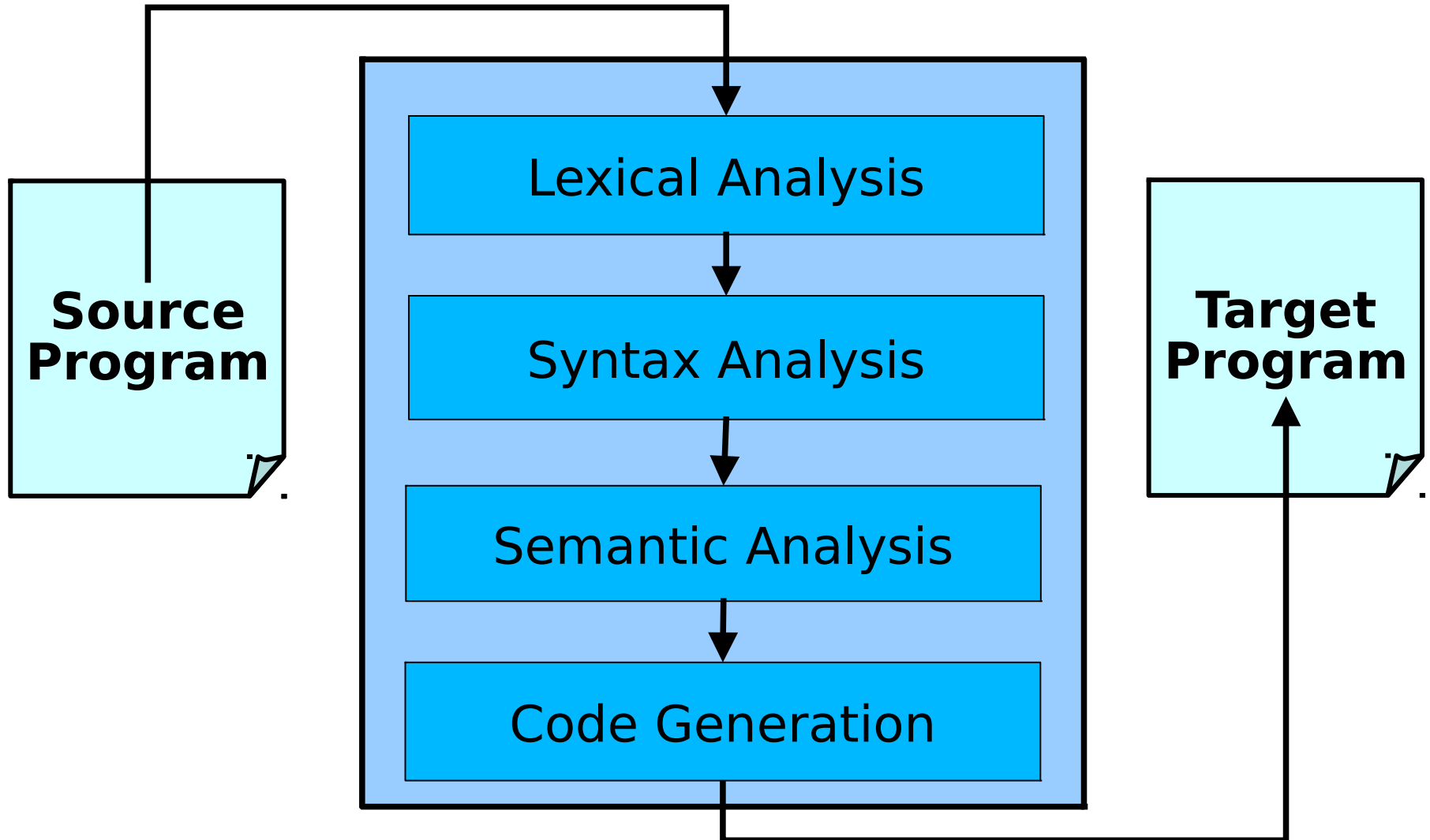


Program that a computer understands

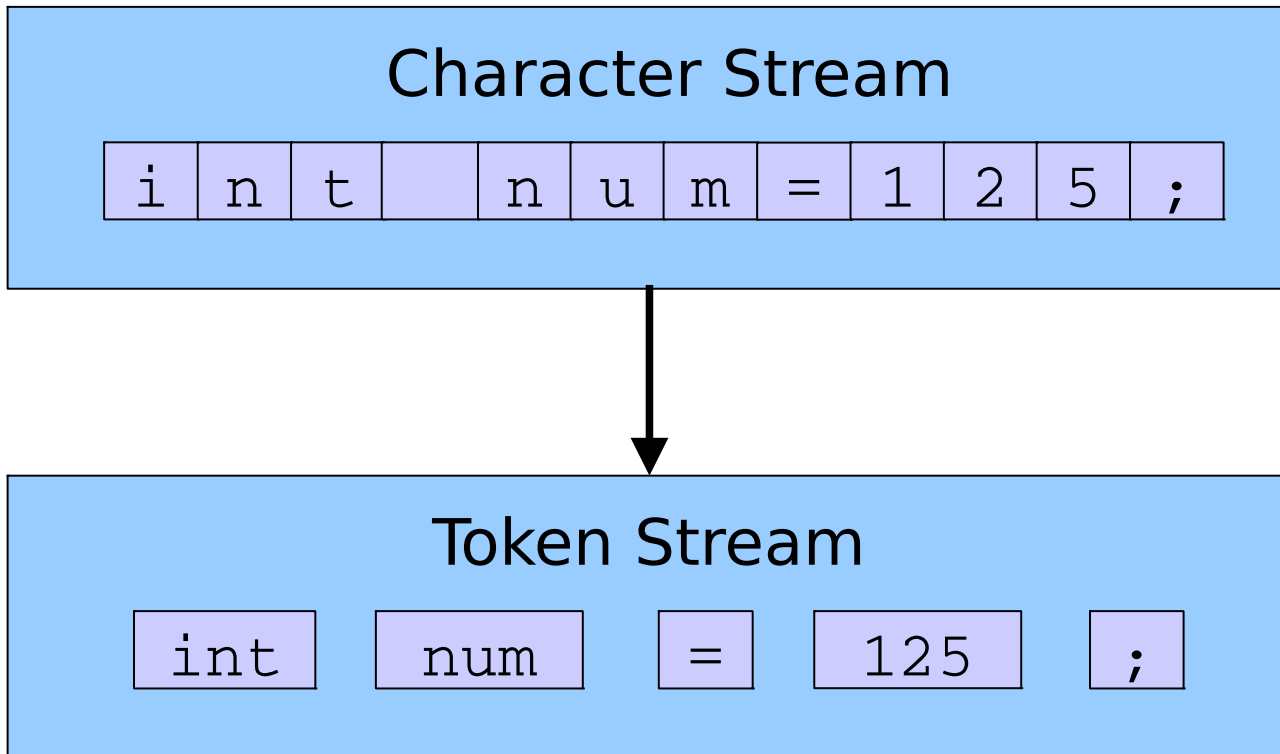


Translator for Language X

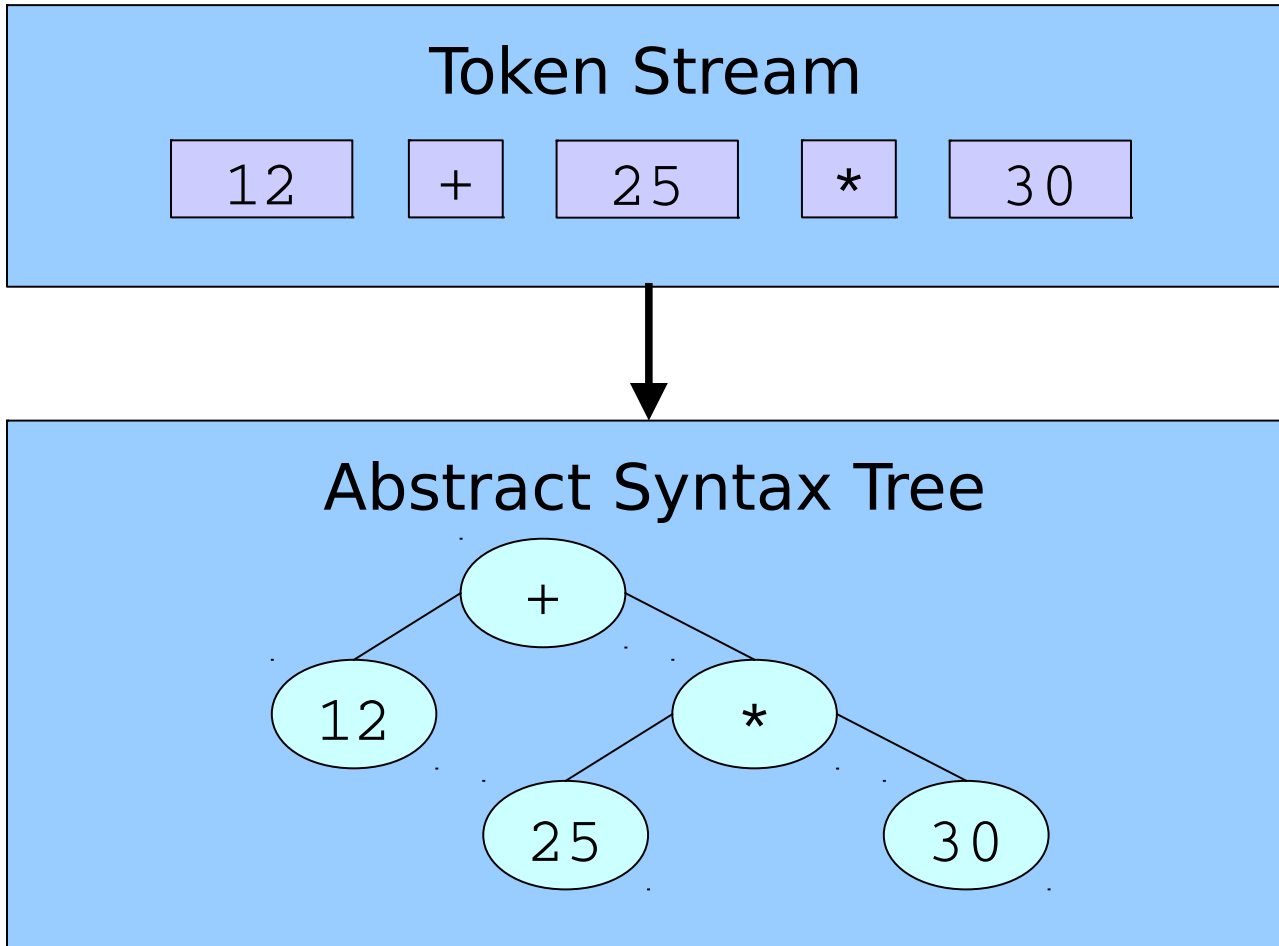
Translation Phases



Lexical Analysis

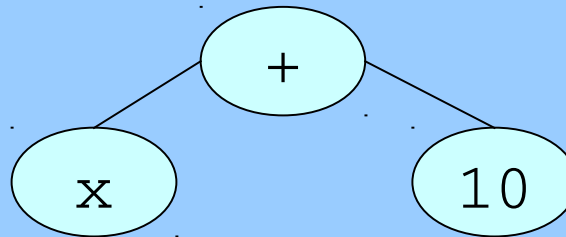


Syntax Analysis

Abstract Syntax Tree

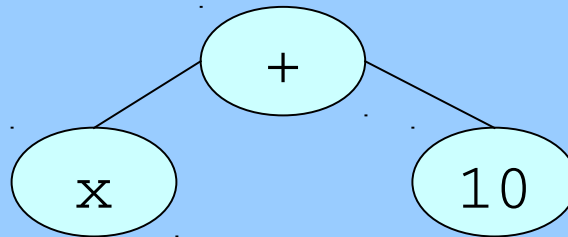


Check that:
